This page shows final results data for pupils who completed key stage 2 in the summer of 2024. These figures were published in April 2025.

Progress score in reading, writing and maths

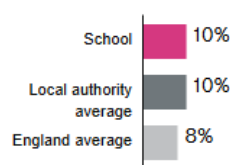

Pupils meeting expected standard in reading, writing and maths ?



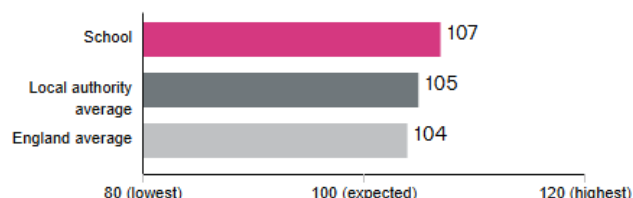
Pupils achieving at a higher standard in reading, writing and maths ?
